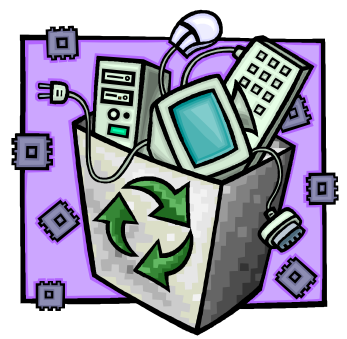

Newspaper Magazines/Catalogues

Advertising inserts, catalogues, flyers, telephone books

Paper Egg Cartons

Corrugated Cardboard

used for shipping stereos, furniture or groceries- must be flattened

Boxboard

Cereal, detergent, shoe boxes

Mixed & Office Papers

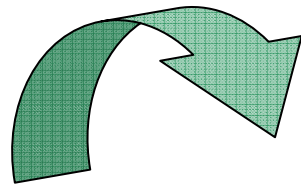
Junk Mail, writing paper, envelopes, brochures & coupons

Brown Paper Bags

Grocery & store bags

Polycoat

Milk and juice cartons and Tetra Pac drinking boxes



CONTAINERS

Glass Bottles & Jars

Please remove lids, Clear beverage & food containers.

Metal Beverage Food Cans

Please rinse & crush

Rigid Plastic Bottles

Antifreeze, windshield washer, milk, fabric softener etc.

Aluminum Trays & Foil

Mixed Plastic

Margarines, ice cream yogurt, ketchup, shampoo etc.

Plastic Film

Place bags inside each other so they don't blow around

Polystyrene

(Styrofoam) Meat & baking trays, plastic & foam cups, fast food containers

Acceptable Household Hazardous Waste Classes: latex and oil paints, finishing products e.g. varnish, glues, etc.; used motor oil, auto and household batteries, propane tanks and cylinders; cleaners e.g. bleach, oven cleaner, etc; Aerosol Cans; Solvents i.e. varsol, paint thinners; Pesticides and Herbicides; Pool and Photographic

Unacceptable Waste Classes: Needles/Sharps; PCB'S; Radioactives; Pathological
