Every person that sets a fire under the authority of a permit shall:

1. Keep the permit at the site of the fire.
2. Produce and show the permit to an officer or firefighter on request.
3. Keep the fire under control; have a responsible adult in attendance at the fire at all times, and a means to control or extinguish the fire.
4. Extinguish the fire before expiration of the permit or upon cancelation of the permit or the declaration of a fire ban or restrictions.
5. Extinguish the fire at any time there cannot be someone in attendance.

By signing below the applicant has read and hereby agrees to abide by the following restrictions:

- 1) Burning will not be permitted with winds over 25 km/hr.
- 2) Adequate water supply or extinguishing agent on site to control and/or extinguish.
- 3) Adequate equipment on site in order to control and/or extinguish (water, shovels, sand).
- 4) Have no more than One (1) pile/fires burning at any time.
- 5) Burn barrels/incinerators or containment equipment is to be maintained in good working condition.
- 6) No materials will be ignited or allowed to burn unless materials are at least 3 meters from any structures, forested area, or other combustible materials.
- 7) Contact the **fire status line** before igniting (starting) the fire to check on fire restrictions, at **249-802-3535**.
- 8) Fire and debris must be spread out to check for hot spots and cold to the touch to ensure the fire is completely extinguished.
- 9) No more than 0.5 Liters of any flammable/ combustible liquid maybe used, as an accelerant.
- 10) Combustibles to be burned are only clean wood, untreated wood products and cardboard paper.
- 11) If smoke may obscure any roadway proper signage must be posted.

Prohibited debris:

The person that sets a fire under the authority of this permit **shall not** burn the following materials:

1. Manure;
2. Livestock or other animal carcasses;
3. Material that will result in the production of dense black smoke including insulation from electrical wiring or equipment, asphalt roofing materials, hydrocarbons, plastics, household plastics, rubber materials or treated wood; and
4. Herbicides, pesticides or any other toxic material or substances.

The applicant and/or the corporation, agents, guests, club or groups represented by the applicant assumes full responsibility for any cost incurred by the Township, including wear or damages to equipment, to control or extinguish the fire and/or fires caused by the said fire or its products.
