We do not have curbside pick up in Minden Hills. You need to take your garbage and recycling to one of our four Waste Disposal Sites.



Visitors to the area will need to use a "One Time Waste Disposal Pass" in order to enter any Minden Hills Waste Disposal Site.



Three (3) bags of garbage in a clear bag are permitted per One Time Waste Disposal Pass.
Additional bags of garbage will be subject to a fee. Clear garbage bags are mandatory.



Recycling is mandatory. You must sort your blue box recycling into Containers and Fibres.
