

1. WATER SERVICE NEEDS TO BE LEFT ON TO PROVIDE WATER TO OTHER AREAS OF THE CAMP
2. PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION FENCING ALL AROUND THE CONSTRUCTION SITE.
3. ALL DISTURBED SOIL IS TO BE SEEDED WITH GRASS SEED AFTER BUILDING CONSTRUCTION.
4. PROVIDE CONCRETE PADS UNDER EACH PROPANE TANK AND EMERGENCY GENERATOR. SIZES 10FEET LONG BY 4 FEET WIDE FOR EACH PROPANE TANK AND 5 FEET X 3 FEET FOR THE GENERATOR. PADS TO BE 6" THICK WITH 6" X 6" - 10" X 10".

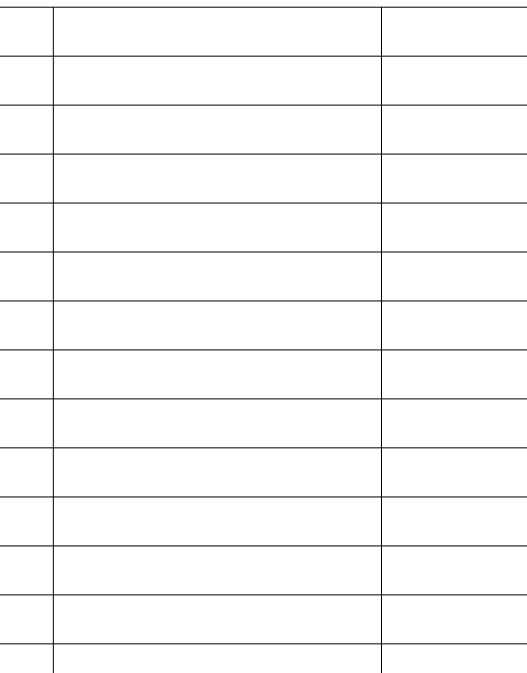

HATCHED AREA INDICATE
LANDSCAPE RESTORATION AS PER NATURAL HERITAGE EVALUATION :

- SILT CONTROL ARE TO BE PROPERLY INSTALLED ALONG THE TOE OF ROCK SLOPE AND MAINTAINED GOOD WORKING ORDER UNTIL THE END OF MAY OF THE YEAR FOLLOWING PLANTING. WHILE TRADITIONAL SILT FENCING THAT IT PROPERLY IN THIS ARE SILT SOXX, A BIODEGRADABLE TUBE FILLED WITH WOOD CHIPS THAT CAN BE QUITE EASILY STAKED INTO THE GROUND, AND WHICH REQUIRES NO ONGOING MAINTENANCE ONCE PROPERLY INSTALLED;
- A GRADE-AL OR EXCAVATOR BE USED TO CAREFULLY DEPOSIT AND SPREAD A SANDY TOPSOIL INTO VOIDS IN THE ROCK, AT AN APPLICATION RATE OF 15 CM (1 M3 FOR EVERY 6.7 M2 OF AREA, OR 36 M3 IN TOTAL). IT IS NOTED THAT THIS WILL LEAVE SOME EXPOSED ROCK, BUT WILL FILL A CONSIDERABLE MOUNT OF THE VOIDS;
- NATIVE SHRUBS/SMALL TREES WHICH ARE RESISTANT TO OPEN, DRY SLOPE CONDITIONS ARE TO BE PLANTED AT A MAXIMUM SPACING OF AVERAGE 1.75 M APART. TO ACHIEVE THAT DENSITY, A MINIMUM 100 SHRUBS/TREES ARE TO PLANTED. SPECIES USED SHOULD ALSO BE ONE WHICH SPREAD VEGETATIVELY, AND WHICH THEREFORE SUBSTANTIALLY INCREASE THE DENSITY OF VEGETATION OVER THE SHORT- TO INTERMEDIATE-TERM. SUBSTANTIALLY INCREASE THE DENSITY OF VEGETATION OVER THE SHORT-TO INTERMEDIATE-TERM. A MINIMUM OF THREE OF THE FOLLOWING SPECIES ARE TO BE USED, WITH NO INDIVIDUAL SPECIES MAKING UP MORE 40% OF THE PLANTINGS:
 - STAGHORN SUMAC RHUS TYPHINIA (1 GALLON POTTED STOCK)
 - SMOOTH SUMAC RHUS GLABRA (1 GALLON POTTED STOCK).
 - SNOWBERRY SYMPHORICARPUS ALBUS (1 GALLON POTTED STOCK)
 - SERVICEBERRY AMELANCHIER CANADENSIS (1 GALLON POTTED STOCK)
 - PIN CHERRY PRUNUS PENNSYLVANICA (1 GALLON POTTED STOCK)

ONCE PLANTED, THE SLOPES ARE TO BE ALLOWED TO NATURALIZE, WITH IT BEING RECOGNIZED THAT SOME OF THE PLANTINGS ARE NOT APT TO TAKE; 70% SURVIVALS CONSIDERED A SATISFACTORY OUTCOME.
